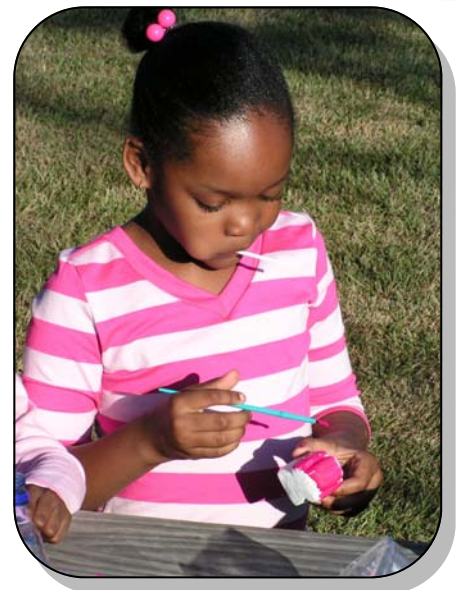

General Information For Enrichments & Day Camp

Enrichment classes are an opportunity for students to participate in a unique program in order to (1) upgrade or update present skill levels; (2) prepare for upper grade skills; (3) improve personal life; (4) become better informed; and (5) learn new arts and skills for greater enjoyment of leisure time.

ADMISSION

All children who have an interest and ability to benefit from an enrichment course may enroll if age appropriate. Necessary supplies for the course will be available from the instructor, unless stated in class description.

ENROLLMENT

Enrollment in all enrichment classes will be limited to a manageable number; therefore, early registration is desirable. When requests for a course exceed the number who can enroll, applicants will be placed on a waiting list in the order received.

Registration may be completed by mailing the form provided in this brochure, along with your payment for the appropriate fee. The office will be open 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Monday - Friday at 2352 East Highway 193, Layton. Phone number is 771-7141 Extension 540. REGISTER EARLY!!

PAYMENT & REFUND OF WEEKLY FEES FOR ENRICHMENTS & DAYCAMP

Payment must be made at the beginning of each week unless paying in advance. A late fee of \$10 will be assessed if not paid by Wednesday. You will be billed \$30 for any returned checks. A pre-registered student who withdraws prior to the beginning of a course will receive a full refund, less a \$5.00 processing fee as long as you notify the office the Thursday prior to the start of class. **If no notification of withdrawal is made to the office in writing on the Thursday prior to the class, you will be charged the full amount for the class.** Notice of withdrawal and request for refund must be made by the parent, *not the student*, in writing to the Accounting Office on the withdrawal form. In the event that your account becomes delinquent, you agree to pay, in addition to your account balance, for all attorney fees, court costs, collection agency fees, commissions and charges in the amount up to 50% of the account balance should your account be turned over for collection.

DISCONTINUED ENRICHMENT CLASS

"Putt-putt" for the fun of it. We will be traveling to a few different miniature golf courses throughout the week. Bring a water bottle and practice your swing!



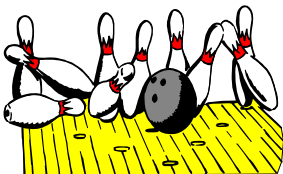

The younger grades will use bumpers to avoid those dreaded gutterballs.

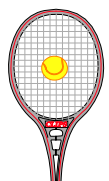

Minute To Win It!!

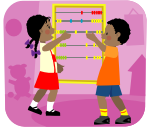
Just like the game show on TV, we will compete in silly skills to beat the clock, all in a Minute! Practice all week for the Grand Finale on Friday for special prizes!!
