## Residential Boarding Student Fees Schedule 2012-2013

LCA is pleased and excited to host and house residential international students on the campus of Layton Christian Academy. We believe the addition of international students has positive benefits for the international student as well as our local student body. To help facilitate international students LCA has an International Student Coordinator. The ISC will interact with the students while on campus, provide support services and periodic activity opportunities. The ISC is also available to answer questions and help international students and their families through the registration process. The residential student house-parents will also interact with school personnel and parents regarding the students needs and progress. The residential program is only available to students in the ninth-twelfth grade. The residential program includes tuition, housing, meals, athletic participation fees, and transportation (to and from school as well as airport runs if necessary). ### Registration

Initial Registration/Commitment Fee- \$1500

*This initial registration fee is non-refundable.*

## Residential Fees-Residential fees are yearly fees

Residential Fees for the 2012-2013 school year is \$19,500.00

The Residential Fees include tuition, housing, meals, transportation, curriculum fees and lab fees.

A deposit of \$5,000.00 is due by June 1, 2012.

Residential fees are due in full by July 25, 2012.

Our residential boarding program is based and planned on a fixed number of students. Students admitted to the LCA Residential Boarding Program are admitted for the entire year; therefore we make no allowances for refund under any circumstances. Should the event of withdrawal for any reason, including both voluntary withdrawal and dismissal, become necessary the student's family is financially responsible for all tuition and fees through the entire year.

If a student enrolls any time during the first semester, the full processing and handling fee will be charged. A second semester enrollee will be charged 60% of the processing and handling fee.

It may be necessary to assess fees for certain activities and supplies during the school year, such as field trips, special events, special classes, school trips etc. Interscholastic sports teams have individual fees that are outlined in the Athletic Handbook.

Additional charges are payable when billed.

An I-20 will be issued after the student has been accepted and the following items have been received.

- Complete Application and Application Fee
- Immunization Record and Health Report w/ TB test results and action taken if required.
- Registration Documents and Enrollment Deposit

Necessary Documents: Pre-Registration Form, Application, Medical Release, Copy of Student's Passport/Visa, Athletic Participation Packet, Transportation/Field Trip Release, Medical Insurance Card, Transcripts in English, English Proficiency Results

### Service Hours

Each family at LCA is required to perform 36 service hours per school year, international students are required to perform 30 service hours per school year. See office for details.
